## SEND White Paper Event

A community event exploring the Government's SEND White Paper will take place on Tuesday **23rd April at 7pm**, offering families, carers, and professionals the chance to better understand recent and proposed changes to the SEND system.

The session will be led by John Friel, an experienced Barrister and HACS Trustee, who specialises in SEND law. John will break down the key elements of the White Paper in clear, straightforward language, explaining what the proposals mean now and how they may affect children, young people, schools, local authorities, and families in the future.

The evening will include expert legal insight, practical guidance, and a dedicated question and answer session, giving attendees the opportunity to raise concerns and seek clarification. The event is free for HACS members, but spaces are limited, so early booking is recommended.
